If you would like to know about the Christian faith and membership at Hope, this class is for you.



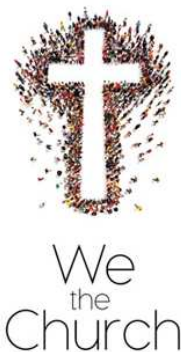
Together we will explore the bible, faith, grace, prayer, the sacraments, and ministries at Hope. There is no obligation to join. Children are welcome.
