1. R/R Gym Door Weather stripping **
2. Basement Classroom Doors (confirm lockable - inspect it for other safety concerns)
3. Sacristy - move receptacle to other side of counter (cord in maint. room) **
4. Ladies Large Bathroom (minor adjustments needed to stall panels) **
5. Shed Door (lock & keys in maintenance closet) **
6. 2nd Floor
(hot water heater & lowboy hot water heater installed in kitchen dishwasher area)
7. Boiler Room
(install 2nd sump pump, correct pitch off drainage piping & redirect water flow from wall)
8. Lobby H.V.A.C System (find date when unit is available to purchase, and order crane and Ross to schedule workday for both companies)**
9. Dufendach Hallway (complete painting project in hallway) **
10. Lobby Doors (install 2nd layer of weather stripping)
11. Haines Rd (classroom window's broken r/r several windows)
12. Kitchen Exhaust (install screen over exhaust hood Outside) **
13. Pre-K Emergency Walkway (r/r walking steps to reach blacktop)
14. Emergency Lighting—several rooms need to be investigated for emergency lighting. Waived by Terri Rambo
15. Outside Reader Board (maintenance on board, burnt out bulbs r/r) **
16. Exterior Boiler Door (r/r photocell & install power to shed)
17. Building in Entirety (make corrections to all thermostats if necessary having to do with A/C consulting appropriate Personnel)
18. Concrete Curbing (new) order protective tire stops
19. Entire Front Parking Lot (fill in large cracks, to extend life of parking lot) **
20. Church Roof (install roof drain covers)
21. Front Stairs (red doors correct steps- chips, cracks)**
22. Tree & Shrubbery (Millcreek tree line & Grove area. Trim hedges & Bushes)
23. Back of Building (install PVC piping along back, to Improve drainage)
24. Front Parking Lot (resurface blacktop)
