Bible Study or Discover Hope will be available for adults.

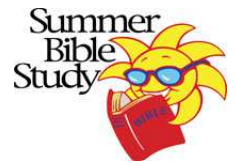

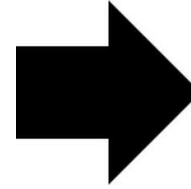
