MEAL PACKING EVENT at Hope Lutheran Church Saturday, May 11 beginning at 10:00 a.m.

Orphan Grain Train (OGT) partnering with Kids Against Hunger (KAH), invites you to help pack 15,000 nutritious meals of KAH-purchased rice, soy, vegetables and minerals to give life and hope to undernourished children of discouraged families of the world.

Volunteers in teams and under the direction of KAH will weigh, scoop, bag, seal, and box meal packs in production lines with equipment provided by KAH.

All ages can participate – children, youth, parents and seniors – there's a task for everyone.

These meals not only restore health, but reverse the damaging effects of food deprivation for those who are starving. These meals will be shipped by OGT to wherever in the world the need is greatest.

Only have a few hours available to volunteer?

STEWARDSHIP SNIPPET: John 21:6

"He said to them, 'Cast the net on the right side of the boat, and you will find some.'

So they cast it, and now they were not able to haul it in, because of the quantity of fish."

Won't the disciples ever learn?

Jesus pulled this same trick before.

When the odds seemed completely against it, the Lord gave them a command to let down the nets, a command that seemed crazy.

But they complied, and He blessed their obedience.

When will we learn this lesson, too?
