Thursday May 16, 2019 ... Hope played it's second game of the season. We welcomed another new player, Steven Smith, to the lineup. It was a relatively close game, 7-2 going into the bottom the 5th inning. Steven had his official 1st at bat for Hope (with bases loaded....pressure!!!) and singled and scored 1 RBI that sparked a 7 run inning that ended the game with a 12 run mercy rule. 3 for 3 performances from Bill Fuller and Brian Bossler (LCR), a 2 for 2 performance from Chris Urban and lights out pitching from Ray Smith, sealed a **14-2 victory** over Philadelphia Christian Center. *This also marks Curt's official 1st win as head coach for Hope softball!*

Tuesday May 21, 2019.... Despite a 9-0 lead going into the bottom of the 3rd inning, Bucks Community Church scored 14 unanswered runs to take the lead. It was a little to much to overcome as Hope was **defeated** by a score of **14-18**.



PASSING THE PEACE: WHY WE DO IT

At the 10:30 a.m. service we already "Pass the Peace", and we will begin this at our 8 a.m. worship on June 16th.

Passing the peace is a tradition rooted in Scripture that embodies our identity as peacemakers (Matt. 5:9; 2 Cor. 5:20).

From the beginning, Christians have exercised this practice.

"Peace be with you" is a greeting Jesus used with his disciples (Luke 24:36; John 20:19, 26).

THE GESTURE IS SIMPLE, BUT THE MEANING IS PROFOUND.

When we extend our hand to another, we identify with Jesus, who extended his life to the point of death to make peace with us.

Likewise, when we pass the peace we practice God's call to "maintain the bond of peace" (Eph. 4:3) with each other.

We make peace with each other before we give our offerings and come to receive Holy Communion.

It may take a little while for people to feel comfortable with this practice.

Please be respectful of those who may not be able to participate.

Passing the Peace is much more than saying, "Good morning."

It is our time to recognize our Christian friends ...

and to Pass God's Peace.
