First Communion:

Along with their parents, children 7 years old and older who desire to receive Holy Communion may attend First Communion classes.



Many churches now offer First Communion prior to Confirmation so children may benefit from this and grow in their faith.

Parents (or guardians) and children in grades 2 and later will attend 3 classes at their age level, taught by Pastor Rich, to learn about this special gift from God.
