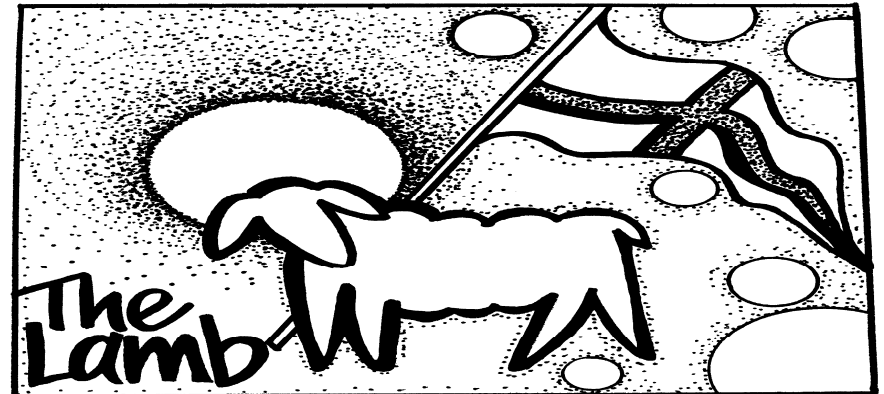

Stewardship Snippet

January 19 - Second Sunday after Epiphany

John 1:29 – "The next day he saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, 'Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!' " The Israelites of old offered a lamb to God at Passover so that death might pass over them and do no harm. Over those long centuries of sacrifice, did they understand that this was actually God's gift? Did they understand that God would be the true Giver of the true Lamb? Truly, we can never out give God, for all that we have is His.
