- ◆ All subjects are taught in the light of God's Word.

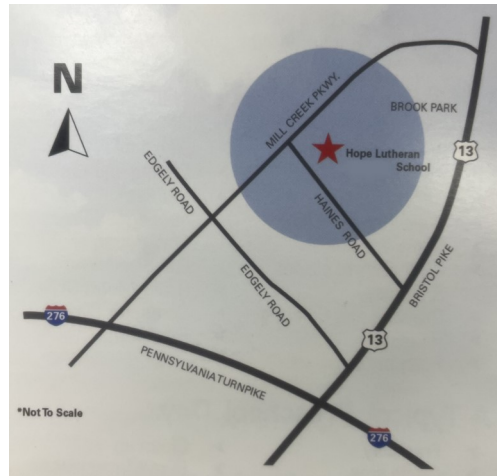
