OUR CURRICULUM INCLUDES...

Religion: Bible Stories and songs, weekly chapel

Language Arts: Whole language-based with an emphasis on phonics, poetry, folk tales from around the world, beginning and ending sounds, word-family rhyming, comprehension, sequencing, oral reading and small motor skills. Our curriculum introduces 100 sight words to the children over the course of the year. Students also are engaged in writing workshop which enhances the students ability to express themselves through different writing styles.

Science: Introduction to Weather, Plants, Animals and their environments

Math Readiness: Number recognition with emphasis on numbers 1-30, addition and subtraction facts to 10, basic geometric figures, graphs, telling time, and using money.

Social Studies: Current events, holidays, and special events.



Gym: Children can utilize our beautiful gymnasium and soccer field to learn and participate in physical activities.

Art: Work on small motor skills, through the use of scissors, gluing, painting, clay projects and creating holiday crafts.

Music: A special Music teacher works on choral selections & the history of music by integrating instruments and rhythm.

Computers: Children are introduced to the computer via Chromebooks & learn keyboarding with age-appropriate software while in our lab.
